The Western Region/Area I 4-H Horse Show has been RESCHEDULED for Friday, August 14 and Saturday, August 15, at the West TN Ag. Pavilion on the campus of UT Martin. On Friday, the show will begin at 5:00 p.m. with our Speed Classes.

The Hunter Division Classes, Western Division Classes and the Gaited Division Classes will be held on **Saturday, August 15** at the **West TN Ag. Pavilion**, beginning at **9:00 a.m.**

The deadline for entries is **Monday, July 6** in the **County Extension Office**. Entries for the Regional Show will be made on-line. Use the region/area show list of classes (1-50) to enter the regional show on the enclosed "Area 4-H Horse Show" entry form (F780).

Note that this information is subject to change adhering to UT policies to COVID-19 response.

NOTE: Be sure to check the Western Region 4-H Horse Show Guidelines enclosed in the entry packet to make sure the entry forms are correct. There are classes with entry restrictions! <u>For 2020, contestants will be able to enter more than one halter class per division.</u> <u>However, you can still only enter one horse or pony per class. Also, the Gaited Division</u> <u>Classes have been rearranged.</u>

SPECIAL NOTES:

- The Tennessee 4-H Championships Handbook will be the guide for the regional show. The same eligibility rules apply.
- CLASSES CANNOT BE ADDED AT THE SHOW DELETIONS ONLY.

Stalls will be available for a fee of \$20 per stall for the first night (\$12 for each additional night). One bag of shavings is included in the first night's fee. Additional shavings will be for sale for \$7 per bag. No outside shavings permitted. According to Ag. Pavilion personnel, there will be no need to reserve stalls. A representative will be available, beginning at 8:00 a.m. Friday, to accept payment and unlock stalls. Counties wishing to be stalled together should attach a note to their entry forms indicating the number of stalls needed.

- RV hook-ups are available for \$25 per day.
- Registration will begin at 3:00 p.m. at the West TN Ag. Pavilion on Friday, August 14. Registration will open at 7:00 a.m. on Saturday, August 15.
- All exhibitors must have a "Proof of Negative Coggin's Test" within 12 months of show date. COGGINS PAPERS WILL BE CHECKED AT THE REGISTRATION DESK BEFORE EXHIBITOR NUMBERS ARE ISSUED.
- No dogs allowed in the indoor arena. Dogs on the premises must be on a leash.
- For 2020, exhibitors can enter MORE THAN ONE Halter Class per division. They can enter a halter mare and a halter gelding in any or all of the listed age classes, if they desire. Halter divisions are Western, Hunter and Gaited. This is keeping with the new state show rule that allows exhibitors to show in more than one halter class.
- Only ONE HORSE or PONY can be entered per class.
- A Walk/Trot Class is a Beginner Class for Beginning Riders, NOT Young Horses. Exhibitors entering Walk/Trot will only be eligible for Showmanship and/or Halter.
- Ponies entering classes #31 (Western Pleasure Ponies) and #16 (Hunter Under Saddle Ponies) may not enter corresponding Western Pleasure Horse (#32 & #33) or Hunter Under Saddle Horse (#14 & #15).
- Horses entered in class #42 (Gaited Pleasure) may not enter classes #43, #44, #45 or #46.
- In the event that two 4-H'ers (1 Junior and 1 Senior) will be showing the same horse in Showmanship classes, please make a note of the fact on the entry form. Arrangements will be made for one member to show early in the showmanship class and the other member will be placed later in the working order.

- The Hunter Hack fences will be set at: Small Ponies (54 inches and under) jump 2 ft.; Large Ponies (Over 54 inches, but not exceeding 58 inches) jump 2 ft.; and Horses to jump 2 ft. 6 inches.
- Ranch Pleasure (Classes #36 & 37) and Ranch Horsemanship (Classes #38 & #39): There are specific guidelines related to Attire and Tack.
- Horses entering Ranch Pleasure (Classes #36 & 37) and Ranch Horsemanship (Classes #38 & #39) **MAY NOT** enter corresponding Western Pleasure (Classes #32 & #33) and/or Western Horsemanship (Classes #34 & 35).
- Classes #5 & #8 (Pony Barrel Racing and Pole Bending) Ponies entered in these classes **MAY NOT** enter corresponding Barrel Racing and Pole Bending classes (Classes #3 & #4 and Classes #6 & #7, respectively).
- Classes #47 & #48, Sr. and Jr. Walking/Racking Equitation, will include an equitation pattern. Horses will work the posted pattern individually. After completing the pattern the class will do rail work.
- During the Speed Show, the guidelines for legal tack and equipment will be enforced.
 - Nosebands, Martingales or Tie-downs No bare metal or wire may be in contact with the horse's head
 - Prohibited equipment
 - Wire chin straps, regardless of how padded or covered
 - Any chin strap narrower than ¹/₂ inch
 - Riders MAY NOT be secured to the saddle or stirrups in any way, including, but not limited to, to the use of Velcro on the saddle and/or rubber bands on the stirrups
- Note that Walking/Racking Showmanship (Class #40) and Gaited Halter (Class #41) have been moved to before the rail classes for the Gaited Division.
