4-H is a youth organization that promotes leadership, citizenship, team work, and life skills. It has programs for students in the 4<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grades. There are many opportunities for the high school student in various project areas.

## Activities:

Students may be a part of the State 4-H Honor Club program after 7<sup>th</sup> grade. There is a regional program that provides citizenship and leadership opportunities for 9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> graders at Regional Retreats 3 times a year. There is a National Leadership Conference held in Tennessee in September.
